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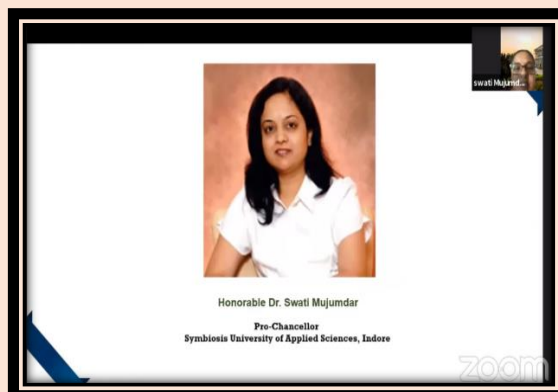
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SKILLS CONCLAVE

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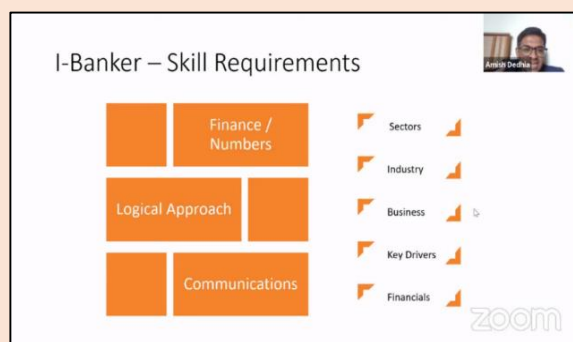
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SKILLS CONCLAVE

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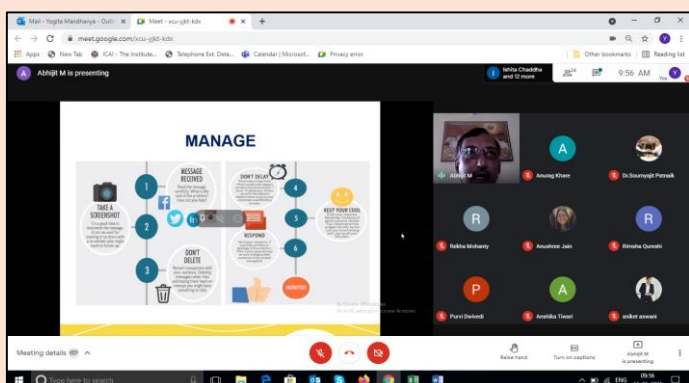

Personal Branding

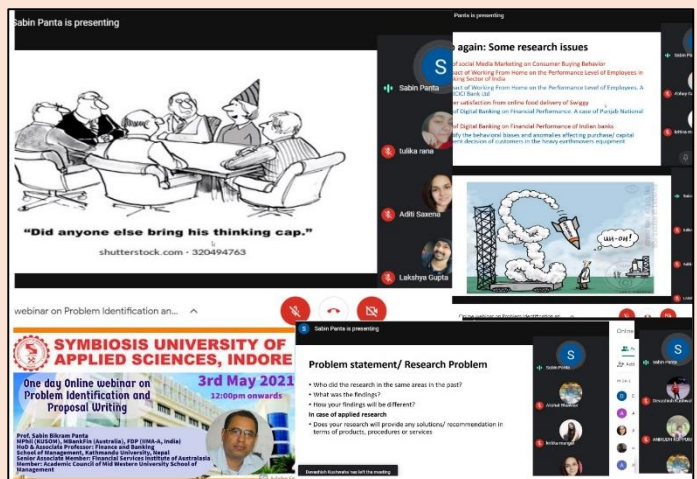

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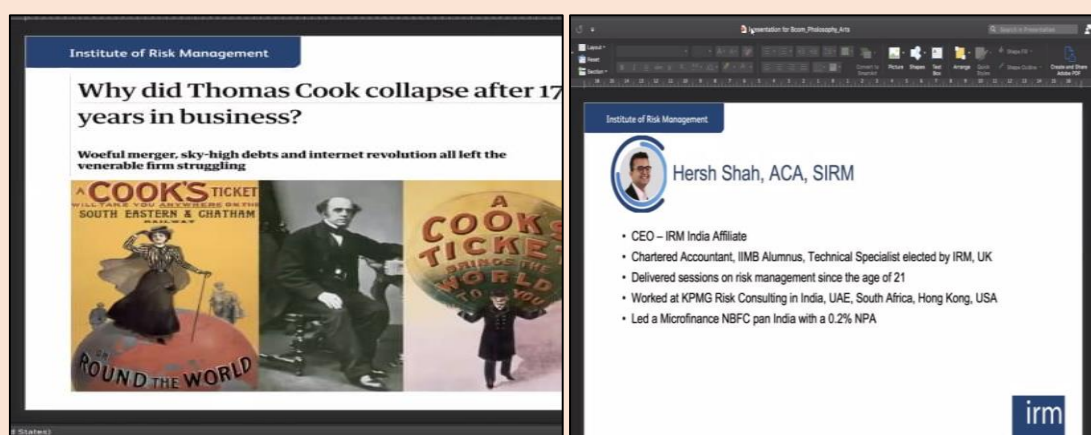


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WEBINAR CONNECTS

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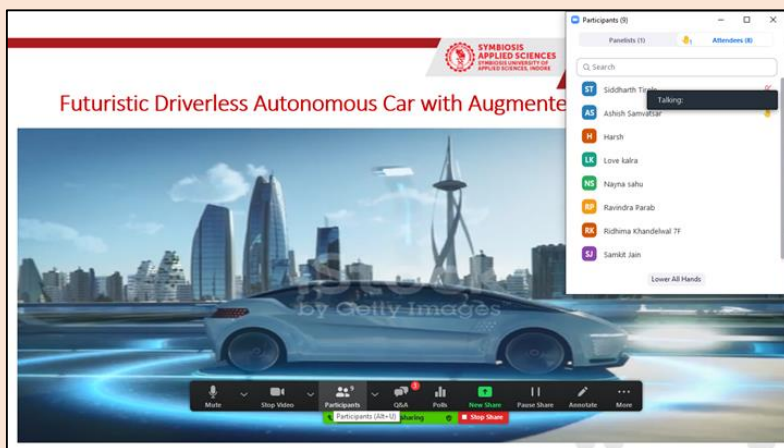

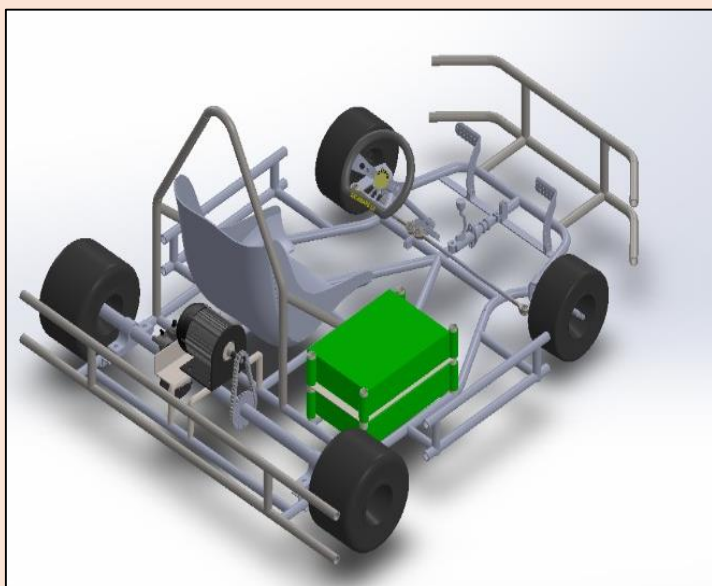
Go-kart Design Challenge

3 Conducted webinar as a guest speaker on the topic "An effective and Agile ERP platform for robust management."

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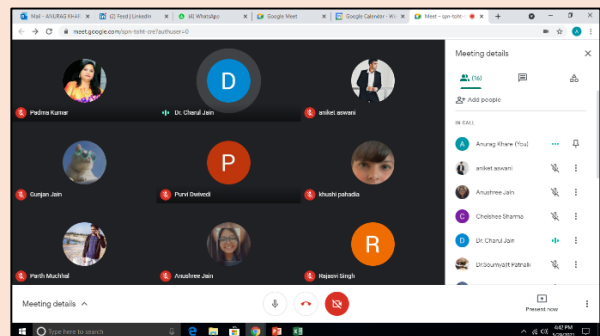
EVENTS

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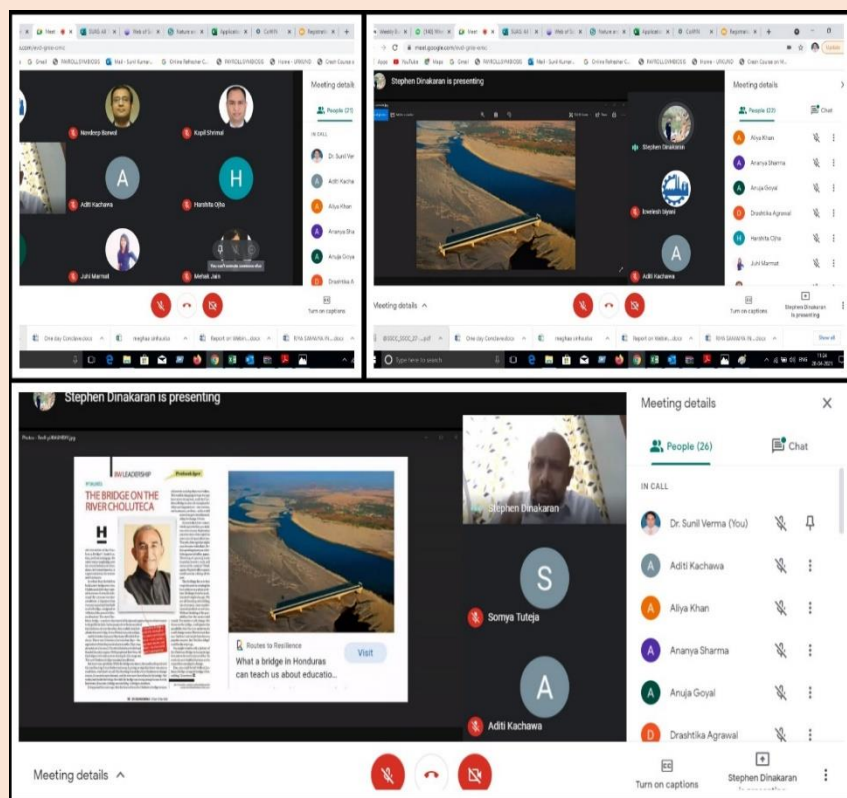


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WORKSHOPS
